Admission

Age limit calculated as on 1st June of the complete academic year.

3. UKG - 5½ years

The following documents are to be submitted at the time of admission.

1. Application form duly filled in all respects
2. Photo copy of Birth Certificate
3. Photo copy of Community Certificate
4. Photo copy of Aadhaar Card
5. Passport size photo
6. Original Transfer Certificate issued by the previous school.

Admission And Withdrawals

Normally, admissions are done only in Pre - KG. The child should be 3+ at the time of admission. Original birth certificates will be verified at the time of admission.

Admission for KG will be on interview basis. Std I and above will have to under go entrance exam in English, Science and Mathematics.

Students seeking admission should be accompanied by their parents, who alone can sign the prescribed admission form and pledge to abide by the school rules.

To withdraw a child from the school, the parent should give a written request to the Principal by the end of January. If applied later, Term-I fee must be paid. Transfer Certificate will be issued only when all the payment due is cleared. If a student is withdrawn in the middle of a term he/she has to pay the fees for the whole term before leaving.

Uniform For Students

UNIFORM

Students should come in **Regular Uniform** on all working days except Wednesday & Saturday. Students should wear House Uniform on Wednesdays & Saturdays except during Examinations.

Boys : KG to V - Green Shirt (Half Sleeves) and dark Navy Blue Shorts

VI to X - Green Shirt (Half Sleeves) and dark Navy Blue Pant

XI & XII - Green Shirt (Full Sleeves) and dark Navy Blue Pant.

Girls : KG to V - Green Shirt and Dark Navy Blue Skirt.

VI to X - Green Shirt (Half Sleeves) Dark Navy Blue overcoat and pant.

XI & XII - Green Kurta (Full Sleeves) Dark Navy Blue overcoat and Pant.

(Black band must be used to plait the hair. Coloured clips, flowers are not allowed to decorate the hair)

(Both boys & girls must wear the school belt, tie, black shoes & socks.)

Decency Decorum And regulations for students

1. To regard the school as his/her second home.
2. Pupil will keep the classrooms and school premises absolutely clean, thus promoting a clean environment.
3. Damage to school property, disfiguring of walls, indecent language or behaviour are serious offences which may entail punishment and even dismissal.
4. Pupil will show respect to school authorities and members of the staff.
5. Resorting to unfair means in the examination and tests is a great offence and may result in detention and expulsion.
6. Identity card should be worn in a proper Manner. If they are damaged it should be replaced immediately.
7. Pupil should be responsible for the safety of their property. They are advised not to bring any costly articles / wear any gold ornaments to the school.
8. A student must obtain prior written permission from the Principal before joining any course which could clash with the school programs.
9. Only English should be spoken in the school premises to acquire greater fluency in the use of language.
10. Collection of funds, giving gifts to any one for any purpose must not be made without the permission of the Principal.
11. Pupil should not bring any magazines or periodicals to the school.
12. In all, it must be noted that the school is keen on the children maintaining a presentable personality in dress, language and outlook. Every pupil is expected to keep the high tone of the school excelling in conduct, good manners and cleanliness.
13. Penalty will be collected for the Breakage of School Property.
14. If a student is involved in any unfair means in the examination, TC will be issued.
15. Electronic gadgets / Mobile Phones are strictly prohibited. If found, using it, the same will be confiscated.
16. Students should be inside the campus on or before 8.50 a.m. If by chance a pupil comes late, an entry will be made in the page allotted for late attendance in the Hand Book.

17. No leave of absence will be granted except on written application from the parents, addressed to the Principal / Class Teacher in advance.
18. If a student is absent for more than 3 days due to illness, the Principal must be informed at once and the student must produce a letter of medical certificate when he/she comes to school.

← For Parents →

1. Parents/Guardians are requested not to meet the children or the teachers during class hours without the prior permission of the Principal.
2. Any communication should be addressed to the Principal.
3. Parents/Guardians are requested to see that their children come to school in neat school uniforms with their hair properly cut and combed.
4. Parents should encourage their child to participate in the school activities.
5. Presence of the parents at the Parent - Teachers meeting is compulsory. Parents can meet the teachers every Thursday at 4.00 p.m.
6. **Students will not be permitted to go home inbetween school hours.** If any emergency parents must come to pickup the child. Parents should avoid planning social functions, outgoing and pilgrimages on school days.
7. Parents should remit the school fees and term fees on the date prescribed without delay.
8. A progress report showing the academic development, with suggestions for improvement, will be sent after each test or examination. The school report must be signed by the parent/guardian.
9. **Kindly provide snacks and lunch along with the students. During the school hours, no parents are allowed to bring the Lunch.**
10. Parents are requested to ensure that their children maintain the textbooks and notebooks in a neat and tidy manner. They are not to be seen tattered, with edges getting smudged or without proper wrappers all through the year.
11. Co-operation between parents and teachers is absolutely necessary for the integral development of the child. Parents should check the diary daily for home assignments, teacher's note to parents etc.,
12. **Changes in the address and Phone number of parents or guardian must be intimated to the school in the written form.**

Request Letter

When an application is made for certificates like 'Bonafide', Payment of fees' etc., it will take minimum of one working day to process such applications. It will not be possible to issue these certificates on the same day. Therefore parents will have to plan their requirement well in advance.

Open Days

1. All parents are requested to make it convenient to attend Open Days without fail.
2. Open Day is a very important programme of the school. These Open Days provide an opportunity for the parents to interact with the teachers, to get to know the progress of their child in academics and other pursuits in the school.
3. Dates of the Open Days will be intimated separately . Progress Reports will be handed over to the parents on the Open Days. They must carefully examine the papers, marks and other remarks and do the needful to improve their ward's progress in their area of weakness and instill regular habits of endeavor for better achievement.
4. If the parents, owing on to some unforeseen reasons are not able to come to the school for the Open Day on the date mentioned, they may come to the school on the following Thursday at 4.00 p.m. and meet the class teacher after obtaining his/her concurrence.
5. Parents are requested to be brief and to the point in their discussion during Open Days. This is to enable that all parents have equal share of time with the teachers.
